



Bark and Bluegrass Festival General Rules and Information:

Alcohol, Glass and Video Cameras are not allowed on the Festival grounds.

Outside food, beverages or coolers are not allowed on the Festival grounds. There will be a wide assortment of food and beverage options available at the Festival. (exceptions to this rule will be made only to accommodate special dietary needs for your family).

Exit and re-entry to the Festival is permitted (only with an intact and unaltered wristband pass). If you cannot find a food or beverage option to your liking on the Festival grounds you are more than welcome to search for options more to your liking from any of the local restaurants in the Old Town Fort Collins area. You will be allowed to re-enter the Festival grounds as long as your wristband is intact and unaltered.

Audio or video taping the music at the festival is “not permitted”.

No frisbee playing in the Festival.

Please use only low back chairs. Highback chairs are allowed only in designated areas.

Tarps are allowed to reserve space and to protect the grass.

Cigarette smoking, dancing & hula-hooping are welcome at the Festival only in areas that are clear of tarps, blankets, chairs & families. Please be respectful of other Festival attendees who may not share your appreciation for these activities. The Festival is being held in a very large, public area and there is room for everyone to enjoy themselves. Please avoid infringing on other attendees enjoyable Festival experience while enjoying your own.

Children 10 and under are free for the Festival, but must be accompanied by a paying adult.
